We are looking for a passionate **Pasifika Creative Artist to share** and impart their knowledge and love for Pasifika dance, language and culture with the next generation of young learners

## Requirements

- → Skill and experience in Pacific Dance (one or more Pacific Dance forms)
- Passion for Pacific Dance and willingness to teach your cultural knowledge and skills to children
- Passion and experience of working with school aged children of all cultures
- Excellent communication skills
- Strong attention to detail and ability to multi-task
- Excellent time management skills, including prioritization, scheduling and adapting when necessary
- Availability to work appx. 10 12 hours per week for 25 weeks (usually 3 mornings per week i.e. 9am - 1pm)

## Roles and Responsibilities

- Plan lessons for the delivery of the Pasifika Proud programme in your allocated schools
- Choreograph Pacific dances to specific music or songs
- Teach Pacific Dance choreography to school students towards a performance at the Marlborough Pasifika Festival/Pasifika o Aoraki Festival (Timaru)
- Coordinate costume ideas with school teachers and Pasifika Festival school liaison
- Attend Marlborough Pasifika Festival/Pasifika o Aoraki Festival (Timaru) to coordinate your school's performance items
- Work collaboratively with Festival organisers to ensure delivery of performance outcomes for your schools – this will include planning and providing information pre-event
- Weekly administration including planning, reporting and attending team meetings
- Provide programme insights and complete end of project reporting
